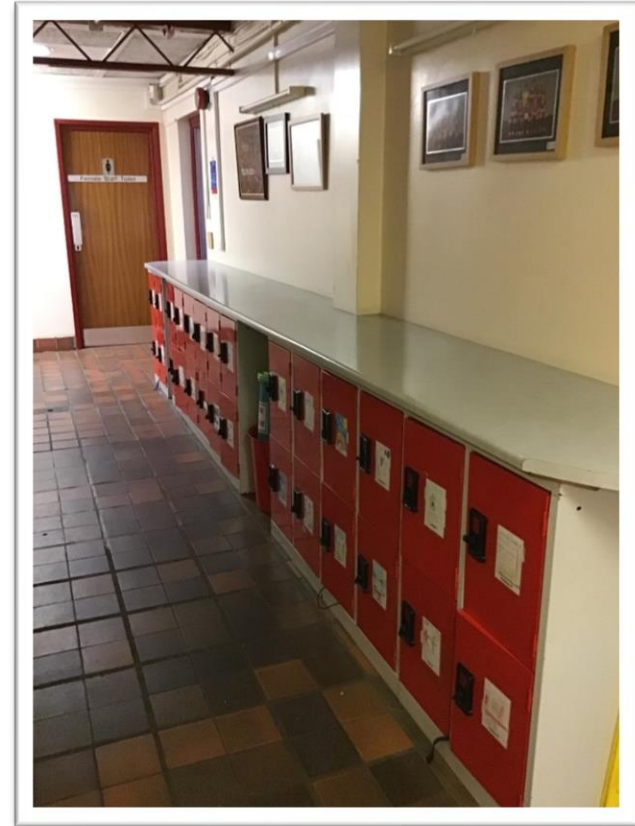

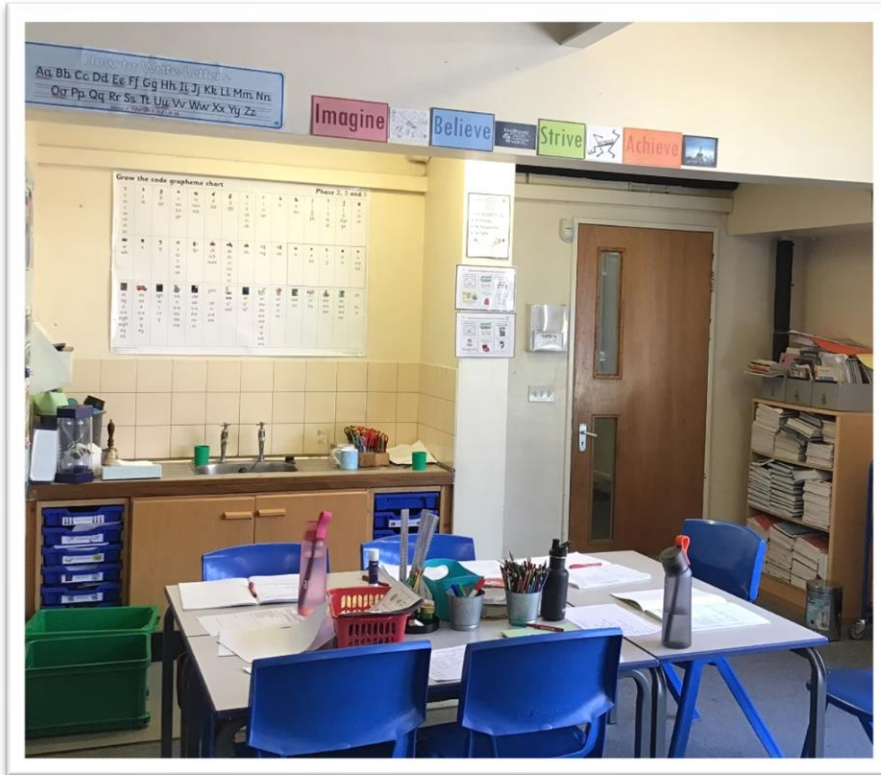

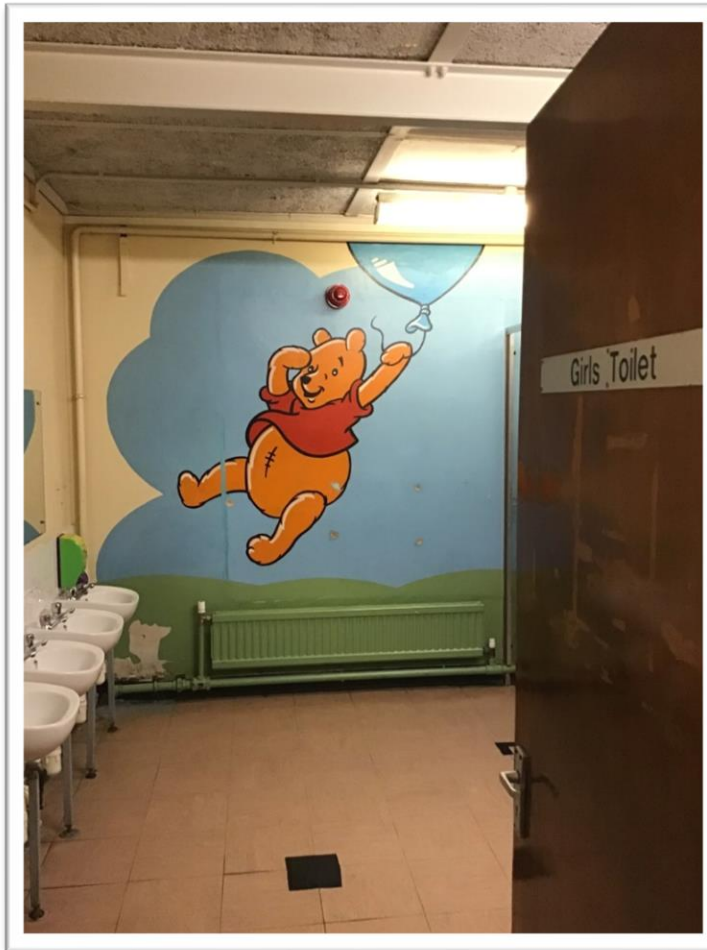

Zones of Regulation

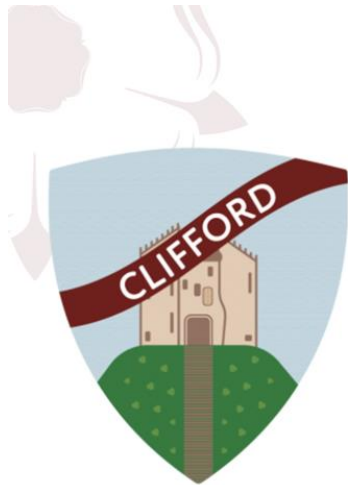

Our House Points



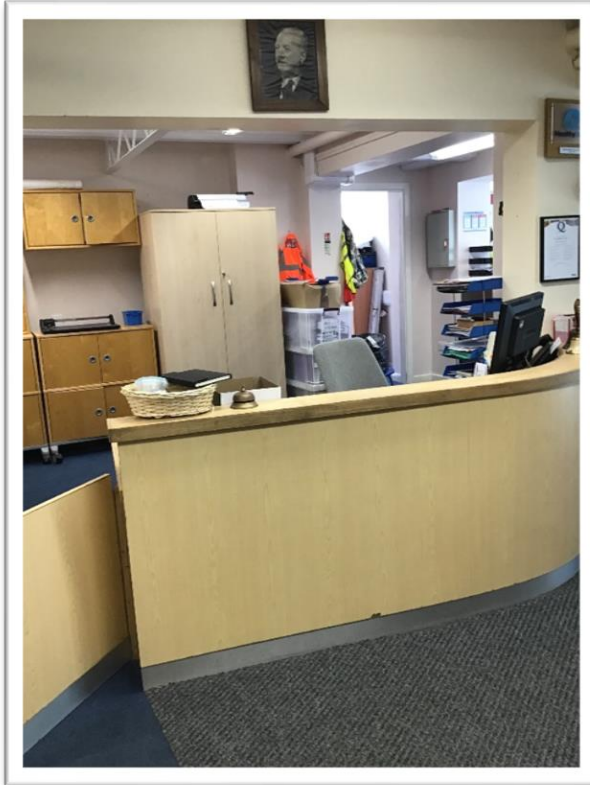
House Points are awarded by all staff to children for a variety of reasons. For example:
