Mission Statement

R.B Kids Club aims to provide high quality childcare within a warm and welcoming environment. The individuality of each child in our care will be respected and nurtured.

Aims and objectives

R.B Kids Club aims to:

- Offer an inclusive service, accessible to all children in the Ralph Butterfield Primary School community when they wish to access our service.
- Ensure each child feels happy, safe and secure, allowing them to learn and develop freely in a play centred environment
- Encourage children to take responsibility for themselves and their actions
- Encourage children to develop positive attitudes and respect for themselves and others, in an environment free from bullying and discrimination
- Provide a wide range of resources and equipment which can be used under safe and supervised conditions
- Offer a programme of activities which meets the needs of each child, promoting their physical, intellectual, emotional and social development, enabling them to become confident, independent and co-operative individuals
- ❖ Work in partnership with parents to provide high quality play and care
- Review and evaluate our services to ensure that we continue to meet the needs of children in our care and those of their parents or carers
- Communicate effectively with parents and carers, and to discuss experiences, progress and any difficulties that may arise
- Employ experienced, well trained staff and offer them appropriate support
- Comply with the Children's Act 1989, the Childcare Act 2006, and all other relevant legislation
- Work in partnership with Ralph Butterfield Primary School and the City of York Council

When can I go to R.B Kids?

Early Bird Club

Our morning club runs from 7:45 am and children can be dropped off at this time. We have colouring sheets, games, the WII, IPADS and games to play for a nice relaxed start before school. We don't provide breakfast but you are free to bring a (NUT FREE) snack. Children are then accompanied by Kids Club staff to their classroom ready for the start of the school day.

After School Club

After School Club starts at 3:25pm. Each class teacher has a copy of the register so they know which children are attending. Children are collected from each class by a member of staff and taken to Kids Club. At Kids Club children have access to water through the session and a snack is provided. If you would like your child to have a pack up then we can store these in a fridge.

Children can relax on the WII, play games, take part in craft activities or play outside. Physical activity is always available at After School Club if the weather is too bad then we use the hall.

Training Day

R.B Kids Club doesn't run a holiday provision (we can sign post to other settings) however we do open 8am-6pm on the five Teacher Training Days though out the Academic Year. Children are able to bring their own scooter or bike to use on the playground. Children are just required to bring a packed lunch. They can also come in their normal clothes.

Cancelling Sessions

All sessions must be cancelled via the r.bkids@Hotmail.co.uk . Please note that bookings cancelled due to illness will not be charged. Sessions not cancelled 24 hours before to avoid charge.

Paying for sessions

All sessions can be paid, weekly, monthly or half termly at the start of the term. You will be guided as to your cost and how to pay on your booking confirmation.

How do I get into Kids Club?

Where is Kids Club?

Kids Club shares the room with Haxby Playgroups (Rising Fives) that you may have used before attending Ralph Butterfield. Reception children are really lucky as their classrooms are next door to Kids Club so you don't have far to walk.



1. Access the car park down the drive here....



We ask when dropping your children at Kids Club that you don't park in the staff car park but on the road. Follow the pictures as shown...



2. Once you have followed the wooden fence all the round, enter through the Reception outdoor classroom.



3. Press the buzzer and wait for a member of staff to let you in. Parents & Carers are asked to wait either just outside or just inside the door (if it's raining).

Where does Kids Club take Place?

Kids Club takes place in our shared room (with Haxby Play Groups) and is next to the two reception classrooms. We have toilets right outside Kids Club.

If the weather is nice we play on the field.

We use the hall to play games in winter.

We play on the playground After School session.
