

## School Projects the PTA have supported

In 2024 the PTA contributed £16,500 to our wonderful new playground. Paying for equipment and playground markings.



In 2023 we paid for 50 donated laptops to be reconfigured and available to use in school plus a wonderful new laptop charging unit



We regularly pay for 'History To Life' actors to come into school and bring Roman, Viking or Egyptian history to life – the children love it!



The PTA purchased and gave every child in school a commemorative pin badge to celebrate the Coronation of King Charles III and also the Queens Jubilee in 2022.



Each year, the PTA pay for all new starter Book Bags with a special gift of a reading book and RB pencil.

We paid for a World Book Day visit from Doctor Who author Daniel Blythe.



We have purchased a number of activity sheds for the Reception outdoor play area. These little sheds provide lots of resources, books and toys which encourage literacy skills, maths/number skills, building activities and art. A fantastic resource for the children to use whilst playing outside.

We purchased new jigsaws for Jigsaw club!



We purchased a diverse set of 150 books including titles for all year groups – the money to purchase these was from a Sponsor a Book appeal

We regularly give each Teacher funds to spend on resources for their classroom. Here a teacher has created a wonderful reading area with a rug, cushions, book storage and seating.



In 2022 the PTA paid for the purchase and fitting of a new Projector screen in the School Hall. Used for assemblies, performances and film nights – benefitting the whole school.
